This data report is compiled per Act 508 of 1999 (A.C.A. 6-61-221) requiring the Reporting of Graduates Requiring Post-Secondary Remediation.

The following worksheets include:

<u>Summary</u> - a summary of six (6) cohort years broken out by All Students and Public High School Students Only. This shows summary tables of the five cohort years and several graphs.

<u>2009 Fall</u> - this is the cohort of students from the 2009 Fall term (Academic Year 2010) and counting all graduates (one time only) since entering.

<u>2008 Fall</u> - this is the cohort of students from the 2008 Fall term (Academic Year 2009) and counting all graduates (one time only) since entering.

<u>2007 Fall</u> - this is the cohort of students from the 2007 Fall term (Academic Year 2008) and counting all graduates (one time only) since entering.

<u>2006 Fall</u> - this is the cohort of students from the 2006 Fall term (Academic Year 2007) and counting all graduates (one time only) since entering.

<u>2005 Fall</u> - this is the cohort of students from the 2005 Fall term (Academic Year 2006) and counting all graduates (one time only) since entering.

<u>2004 Fall</u> - this is the cohort of students from the 2004 Fall term (Academic Year 2005) and counting all graduates (one time only) since entering.

<u>Graduation Rates</u> - this is ADHE's latests official graduation rate calculations. This is provided for comparison purposes.

NOTE:

- (1) Be aware that the number of graduates (and percentage) for the older cohorts will increase as the older cohorts review more graduating academic years than the more recent academic years. For example, the cohort from 2004 Fall reviews graduates from AY2005 AY2012, whereas the cohort for 2008 Fall reviews graduates from AY2009 AY2012 a 8-year review vs. a 4-year review.
- (2) Note that 4-Year Universities offer few programs that can be completed in a 3-year time frame. This explains why the percent graduating for 2009 Fall is only 2.0%. The 2-Year Colleges offer many short-term programs and explains why the percent graduating for 2009 Fall is much higher 13.1%.
- (3) The remedial cohort is based on ADHE's typical calculation of counting students enrolled as a first-time entering degree-seeker (Associate or higher). The only change for this report is filtering for students graduating high school within the last 2 years.
- (4) Smart Core and Non-Smart Core information is not yet available from the Arkansas Department of Education.
