- Baccalaureate and Graduate programs approved between July 1, 2005 and June 30, 2006 (Academic Year 2006).

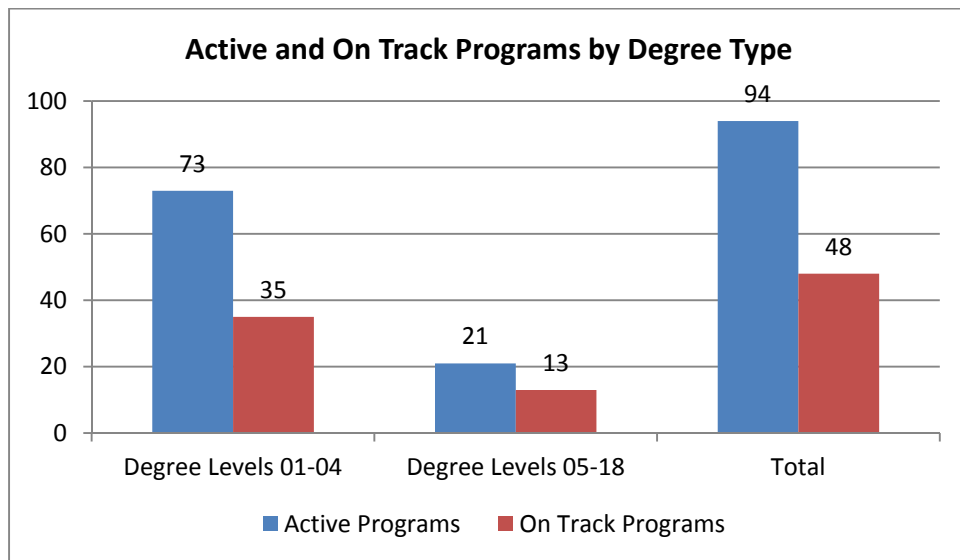
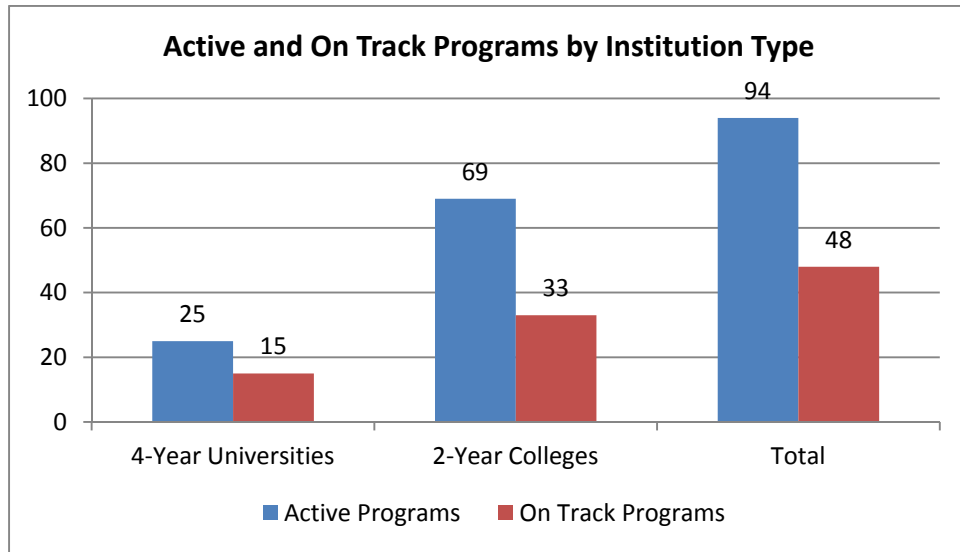
The attachments reflect the number of graduates for the new programs and also identify programs that are on track to meet the viability standards.

The table below summarizes the total number of new programs and those remaining active.

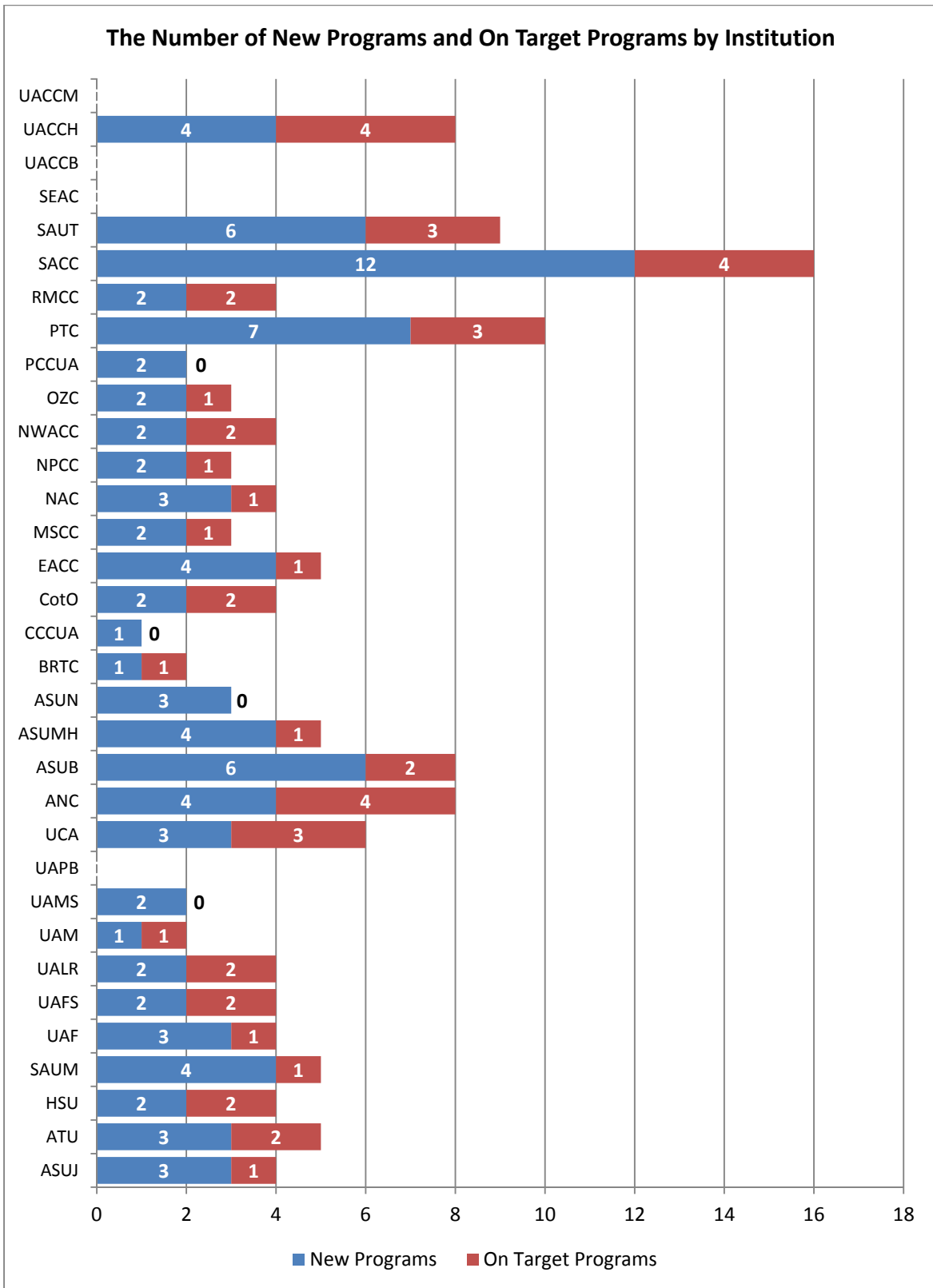

The graph below shows the total number of new programs remaining active (blue) and the number of new programs that are on track to meet the performance standard (red).



Because programs need time to develop and produce graduates, productivity for certificate and associate programs are measured **three years** after approval, while baccalaureate and higher programs are measured **five years** after approval.

Academic year 2011 (AY 2011) is a snapshot of the productivity of certificate and associate programs approved in 2007-08 and bachelor’s degrees approved in 2005-06. The new programs listed on the following pages are required to meet the following AHECB Viability Standards by 2013.
