University of Arkansas – Fort Smith Master of Education in Education

The proposed Masters Degree in Education (M.Ed.) targets licensed teachers in the workforce who desire professional advancement and/or recent graduates who seek advanced knowledge and preparation prior to entering the workforce. The program will be 30 credit hours with two emphasis areas: Curriculum and Instruction and English.

University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff Master of Education (M.Ed.) in Computer Science

The proposed 36 credit hour M.Ed. in Computer Science is designed to provide graduates with the necessary skills and competencies to teach computer science education in grades 4-12. The desired candidates for the proposed program will be educators who have a teaching license in a STEM discipline who desire to further their career by teaching computer science.

Master of Education (M.Ed.) in Educational Leadership

The proposed M.Ed. in Educational Leadership will provide licensed teachers with the leadership skills for positions as an elementary, middle, or secondary school principal or a school administrator or supervisor in Arkansas K-12 schools. Graduates of the proposed program will be qualified for educational leadership and administrative positions in counties and districts, the Arkansas Department of Education, education centers, and private organizations.
